

Your data for your load is telling you to use a magnum primer the Remington 9 1/2 is a magnum primer it will work fine. My load is 45 grains of Varget with a sierra gameking bullet 165 grains C.O.I 2.750. Any bullet .308 diameter will work. But if you can't find exact data for a particular bullet I start a grain or two above a minimum load until I see signs of pressure.

Different rounds require different primers. Your reloading manual will indicate which primer to use. The difference in primers will reflect in the amount of power your gun will ignite. Meaning your gonna need a bigger bang for a 300 win mag than your gonna need for a 223.

Yes you can. I have used them for 308 Winchester as well as 280 Remington loads with good results. You certainly do not need magnum primers but they will work. My only suggestion is that you use slower burning powders like H4831 and, as usual, start with lighter loads and work your way up observing any signs for excess pressure. Always be safe and err on the side of caution. This is especially true if you are using an older rifle.

Great primers with great shelf life too!
I bought a 1000 pack carton of these primers back in the late 70's for loading my 264 Mag and they are still just as powerful and reliable as when I bought them. The shelf life on these primers is just unbelievable (30+ years old) and no squibs or loss of accuracy or reliability. So don't be afraid to buy extra when you are ordering in order to justify paying the hazmat fee. I have also used these in 44 Mag pistol rounds (after deepening the primer pocket on the pistol cases) and have reliable ignition on those rounds too. I shoot them in a Desert Eagle, which needs a diet of pretty hot loads to reliably function the action and these deliver with it.
