

The .404 Jeffery is also known as the .404 Rimless Nitro Express and was introduced around 1909 by W. J. Jeffery.

The cartridge grew to become quite popular as an inexpensive alternative to contemporary dangerous game rifles and established a large following. Typical of British cartridges targeting large game the .404 was a relatively large-bore, low-pressure round propelling a very heavy round-nosed bullet at quite moderate velocity. As such, the large case capacity was greatly under-utilized.

Eventually the .404's appeal would wane and the round would seem relegated to obscurity. However, in the early 1990's, life began anew for the British old-timer when Dynamit-Nobel resumed production and the Ruger M77 bolt-action rifle became available in .404 Jeffery.

The .404's large case would figure prominently in the designs of two notable high-velocity U.S. cartridge series. Dakota Arms has created the .300 Dakota and Remington has released the Remington Ultra

Magnum series (7mm, .300. .338 and .375 cal), all based on the .404 Jeffery. These rounds benefit from the large powder capacity of the .404 case, but of course, operate at much higher pressure than the parent cartridge would sustain.

The .404 Jeffery pushed a 300 grain bullet at 2600 fps with 4500 ft-lbs of energy.

One may not be able to actually reach a full published charge if their gun produces greater pressure than was experienced in the development firearm. **Stay alert when reloading - be careful!**
