# ATF Releases Latest Suppressor Figures

September 30, 2021

WASHINGTON, DC – On Thursday, September 30th, ATF released the latest suppressor figures as part of the 2021 Firearms Commerce in the US report. The report highlights the total numbers of firearms manufactured, sold, imported, and exported in the US as well as various NFA statistics and Federal Firearms Licensee (FFL) data from the previous year.

According to **the report**, these were the major takeaways::

- The total number of suppressors registered in the NFRTR is **2,664,775** as of May 2021
  - This represents a 30% increase (622,056) since April 2020
- A 35% increase in SOT dealers in 2020 (10,537, up from 7,806 in 2019)
  - In the past ten years, the average annual growth was 17%
- A 10% increase in SOT manufacturers in 2020 (6,310, up from 5,716 in 2019)
  - In the past ten years, the average annual growth was 14%

This shows a remarkable growth trend in the suppressor industry in 2020. At this rate, total suppressors will likely surpass the 3 million mark by the end of 2021. We are extremely proud of the role ASA has played over the past ten years to advance suppressor acceptance and ownership. The legalization of suppressors by three states and the growth in suppressed hunting opportunities in 18 states has certainly contributed to the rapid growth and popularity of suppressors.
