



Dr Peter Dollinger (Berne) is one of the most highly respected persons at CITES. He was the CITES Management Authority for Switzerland, (the Depositary Government for CITES) for several decades. At CITES CoPs he was frequently requested to chair Working Groups on a diverse range of subjects. In the early years of CITES he prepared the CITES Species Identification Manuals ... a task he resigned from when the CITES Parties placed 359 species of humming birds (*Trochilidae*) on CITES Appendix II ! He was the Executive Director of the World Association of Zoos and Aquariums and produced reference works for the management, welfare and conservation of animals in captivity. In his retirement, he continues providing, on a voluntary basis, administrative services to the German-speaking Association of Zoo Veterinarians, but his main occupation has become the development of the “Zootier-Lexikon” which contains data sheets on some 2000 animal species and their habitats.
