

If you are booking your flight online and would like to take your sporting equipment with you, then please call your local [Lufthansa Service Center](#) after you have made your online booking. Please register your sporting equipment there under your booking code.

**Please note:** the fees specified in the table are incurred per route in each case (from baggage drop-off to the next baggage check -in) and apply solely to Lufthansa flights and flights that are operated by LH Regional.

The excess baggage fees can be displayed in several currencies. Here the excess baggage is calculated to the place where the bags are checked in and the fees are incurred as follows:

- CAD(for baggage check-in in Canada)
- EUR(for baggage check-in in Europe)
- IDR (for baggage check-in in Indonesia)\*
- USD (for baggage check-in in all countries not previously mentioned)

\*\* The first piece of checked ski or snow boarding equipment is included in the free baggage allowance regulations on all flights except those to/from the USA, Mexico, Belize, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua and Panama and is therefore free of charge. The maximum weight of the first piece of ski or snow boarding equipment must, however, be within the relevant free baggage limits of the respective booking class. Each further piece of ski or snow boarding equipment or the first and subsequent pieces of ski or snow boarding equipment on flights to/from the USA, Mexico, Belize, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua and Panama is charged in line with the fees specified above.

\*\*\* Weapons used for sport or hunting must be declared and are then only charged for if they are transported in a separate weapons case. Small weapons, which are packed in checked baggage and which do not exceed the free baggage allowance, will not incur a charge.  
Exception: an additional charge per firearm is always levied in the following countries: South Africa EUR 50, Italy up to EUR 90, depending on airport, Spain EUR 60, Turkey EUR 30.
