

I use a vertical sander with a 120 or 220 grit belt. I don't think the exact grit is critical. Take your time and let the sander remove material slowly. Remember that the pad's hard backing material will wear away quicker than the more rubbery cushion. Going slowly with light pressure will help keep things even. I've used this jig several times with very good results. My biggest mistake one time was over tightening the screws which compressed the pad slightly. After sanding and removing the pad from the jig, the sides were slightly concave instead of straight. Lesson learned there.

My 6" disk was too small to grind on the down travel side of the disk, the part could be ground, but I found it awkward working at the top of the disk with side pressure, vs downward pressure. I ended up using a 4"X36" belt sander in the vertical position.
