Cull Hunts

Because of surplus animals that need to be reduced to give species the chance to increase their numbers DE KLERK SAFARIS have decided to introduce the concepts of cull hunts to our clients. Cull Hunts can be for male or female animals and are not for trophy animals. Some animals with inferior or broken horns will be hunted. The Professional Hunter in charge of the hunt will point out which animals are to be shot. The idea behind cull hunts is to harvest a great number of animals in a short period .

Hunting nightly rates and package hunts **include:**

- The full time service of a Professional Hunter and camp staff including trackers, skinners, cooks and camp assistants
- Accommodation and full catering
- Daily laundry
- All transportation costs during the safari with fully equipped four wheel drive vehicles
- Field preparation and salting of trophies
- Local soft drinks, beer and alcoholic beverages in moderation

Hunting nightly rates and package hunt **exclude:**

- Accommodation prior to and after the safari
- Air charter fees
- Transportation costs from airport to the hunting area. (Johannesburg - \$400 per vehicle one way) Minibus with transfer company \$800 one way
- Trophy fees of species taken. All animals wounded and lost will be paid in full plus 15% Value Added Tax. Trophies exported have 0% VAT
- Transportation of raw trophies to Johannesburg - \$300 per group

- Dipping, packing and shipping of trophies to final destination
- CITES licence fees and permit fees where applicable
- Rifles can be hired per day at \$50, Double rifles(.470) at \$100
- Ammunition:

- Specially requested imported food and drinks

Terms And Conditions

- Nightly rate are charged per night spent in camp. The reason for this is that the majority of the expenses are about the accommodations, food and drink, service of the chef and camp staff every night and breakfasts in the mornings. Clients do not pay for the last day on the day they are leaving because there is no night spent in camp.
- A deposit is required to confirm the booking and to secure the dates. Unless a deposit is payed there shall be no binding contract.
- No refund of deposit can be made if client cancels safari within 6 months of contracted starting date unless the safari can be re-booked. Should the dates be rebooked or the client cancels the safari more than 6 months before starting date a 10% administration fee will be charged on the total sum of the safari
- All payments to be made in cash or electronic transfer. Unfortunately our bank do not accept any foreign checks anymore. We even have a difficult time cashing traveler's checks
- All reasonable precautions to ensure the safety and good health of clients will be taken. However no liability will be accepted for injury, illness, death or loss of property during or after the safari
