

A solid set of rings but they didn't work on my Ruger No.1. One of the rings is about 1/4" higher than the other, I'm guessing for bolt actions, but because of the level one-piece base on the Ruger No.1 they don't work. Their height is too far off for the scope to mount on them properly. It's a shame since no one else makes quick-detach rings for Rugers.

Although I use and highly ...

Although I use and highly recommend Warne's Weaver-style rings, I was disappointed by their Ruger rings. With the Ruger factory rings, the hooks/catches underneath are rounded, and when tightened automatically center on the matching indentations in the bases. However, rather than design something similar, Warne just modified their existing ring design by adding small squared-off catches underneath which don't sufficiently engage the bases, and don't center themselves. End result: they're difficult to adjust for spacing when mounting, and it's tough to tell when they're mounted securely. Once fully engaged and cranked down, the hold seems solid, but there isn't enough steel-on-steel contact for my comfort, and I wouldn't trust them in the field. Pity, because nobody else makes QD rings for Ruger bases.


